M. Grazia Speranza graduated in Mathematics in 1980 and received her PhD in "Applied Mathematics" in 1983 at the University of Milan. She is full professor of Operations Research at the University of Brescia. She was President of the Research Council, Vice-president of the University of Brescia and Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Business for two terms.

Scientific activity

- Her main scientific interests are: models and algorithms for transportation and logistics, vehicle routing problems, scheduling problems, combinatorial optimization and portfolio optimization problems.
- She is author of more than 100 refereed papers which appeared on international journals such as *Algorithmica*, *Computers and Operations Research*, *Discrete Applied Mathematics*, *Discrete Mathematics*, *European Journal of Operational Research*, *Journal of Heuristics*, *Journal of Scheduling*, *Management Science*, *Naval Research Logistics*, *Networks*, *Operations Research*, *Operations Research Letters*, *Transportation Research*, *Transportation Science*.
- She has been editor of volumes and special issues of journals such as *Annals of Operations Research*, *Computers and Operations Research*, *Discrete Applied Mathematics*, *European Journal of Operational Research*.
- She serves as Associate Editor of *Transportation Science*, *4OR*, *ITOR* and Area Editor for *Logistics, Distribution, Inventory and Transportation* of the *Asia-Pacific Journal of Operational Research*.
- She was Vice-President of IFORS from 2008 to 2009 and is at present President-elect of EURO.
- She has been invited by several universities to give seminars. She has given invited talks at several international conferences.
- She has organized international conferences, such as the first workshop on "Models and algorithms for planning and scheduling problems (MAPSP)" in Como in 1993 and the "International workshop on distribution logistics" in Brescia in 1998 and 2006, and contributed to the organization of others, such as *Odysseus* in Palermo in 2003 and *TRISTAN IV* in the Azores Islands in 2004. She has been member of the Scientific Committee of several international conferences.
